Amendment No 1 to Sailing instructions

Signals Made Ashore

Signal made ashore will be displayed at the Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club flagstaff.

The Schedule of Races

Saturday, 2 nd September	1150	First Warning Signal
Sunday 3 rd September	1020	First Warning Signal

Subsequent races will start as soon as possible after the last boat finishes.

No Warning Signal will be made after 1200 noon on Sunday 3rd September unless there is an error in the starting sequence or general recall.

The Start

Starting Signals are amended in that the Warning Signal will be made 10 minutes before the starting signal, other signals remain unaltered (Amends RRS26). The Starting sequence will therefore be 10, 4, 1, Go.

However, if there is a general recall or a postponement before the start or an abandonment soon after the start, there will be a 5 minute warning signal (5, 4, 1, Go). The removal time of the 'delay' signal being one minute before the warning signal.
