NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organising Authority

1.1 Organised by the Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club.

2. Rules

- 2.1 Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020.
2.2 Classes racing as one designs must conform to their class rules.
2.3 All entries will be allocated a handicap using the CCYC rating system from the information provided.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The race is open to all mono hull sailing boats and classes, owned or helmed by a club member.
3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the required entry fee.

4. Fees

- 4.1 Entries shall be made on the attached form and returned to Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club at the address below by 1100 on 4th October.
4.2 Entry fee is £20.00 per boat of which £10.00 will be donated to the “Andrew Cassell Foundation”

6. Sailing instructions

6.1 The Sailing instructions will be available to each competitor on or after 2nd October 2018.

7. The Courses

- 7.1 The racing area will in the Solent starting from the RORC, Clubhouse Startline.
7.2 Courses using laid or fixed or navigation marks will be broadcast on VHF and texted to the nominate mobile phone.
7.3 A list of marks to be used will be issued with the Sailing Instructions.

8. Penalties

8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. Radio Communications

9.1 The Race Committee will communicate with competitors on VHF channel 37a (M1).

9.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

10. Scoring / Results

10.1 The results will be calculated based on handicaps allocated in NoR 2.3.

10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 Both races are to count.

11. Prizes

11.1 The Cowes Corinthian Trophy will be awarded to the first boat overall.

11.2 Keeper prizes will be awarded for the first three boats overall.

11.3 Keeper prizes will be awarded to the first place overall in any one design class that has more than five entries.

12. Risk Statement

12.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance as is available in Cowes, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- (g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

13. Insurance

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 Sterling per incident or the equivalent.
